



INFORMATION FOR APPLICANTS

Aim

The aim of this scholarship is to provide two people, who have a parent or caregiver affected by MS, with the opportunity to attend an Outward Bound course within the year of the scholarship being awarded.

Who is Eligible?

Those aged 16 . 26 who have a parent or caregiver who has MS. They do not have to be members of a MS Regional Society.

Criteria

The scholarship is designed to provide an opportunity for a student to attend a Classic or MBS course at Outward Bound.

At the time of the application for the scholarship, the student must be:

- Living with a parent or caregiver affected by MS
- NZ Citizen or Permanent Resident;
- Wanting to attend a course at Outward Bound

The applicant should also;

- Demonstrate a strong sense of community value;
- Demonstrate an empathy toward others within the community;
- Significantly benefit from attending a course at Outward Bound.

Scholarship

Two scholarships will be awarded, equally funded by the MS Society and Outward Bound.
